May long weekend (May 18th 19th 20th) Gorge Harbour

Then possibly join *RR Squadron* After the weekend At Octopus Islands trail blazing.

Mid June Cruise/ Race (June 15th & 16th) Join the Major Mystery racers overnight at Finn Bay, Lund or Copeland Islands
